5. START

5.1. NoR 17.2 is e and replaced with:

17.2 Rule 26 is changed as follows:

- At least 5 minutes before the starting signal: Attention signal: displaying a orange flag with white START
- 3 minutes before the starting signal: Warning signal: displaying a black flag with white number 3
- 2 minutes before the starting signal: Preparatory signal: removing the black flag with white number 3 and displaying a grey flag with white number 2
- 1 minute before the starting signal: One-minute signal: removing the grey flag with white number 2 and displaying white flag with black number 1
- Starting signal: removing the white flag with white number 1

6. CHANGE OF COURSE

6.1. To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will:

6.1.1. Lay a new mark

6.1.2. Move the finish line

6.1.3. Move the leeward gate or mark

6.2 When the new mark is laid, the original mark will be removed as soon as practicable. When in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark.

7. OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats will be marked with white flags carrying black letters as follows:

Race committee: white "RC"

Umpire: black flag with "Jury"

Press: "P" or "PRESS" or "Presse"

Repair service: "S" or "Security"

Media / TV: "Media"

8. Attachment E: Course

Mark 1, 2S and 2P will be green inflatables.

Change of course Mark will be an inflatable yellow mark.

Start/ Finish Pin will be a red mark buoy with Orange Flag.

Mark 1 shall be passed on port side Marks 2S and 2P are gate-marks

Sequence: Start – 1 – 2S/2P – 1 – Finish

Colour and shape of the marks may differ from the drawing and are not binding for the regatta. At the start, the pin end may be a RC boat as well as a buoy.
