The first qualifying event of the SAILING Champions League 2024, held from 15. to 17. March in Vilamoura, Portugal, concluded successfully, crowning Åländska Segelsällskapet as the champion.

With impressive skill and tactical prowess, participants navigated through challenging regattas, providing spectators with thrilling competitions and breathtaking sailing action.

After three exciting days of racing, Åländska Segelsällskapet secured the title of Vilamoura Qualifier Champions. Closely followed by Regattaclub Oberhofen from Switzerland and Kongelig Dansk Yachtklub from Denmark, who claimed the second and third place respectively.

The tournament was a triumph for the sport of sailing, underscoring the international significance of the SAILING Champions League as the premier sailing competition series.
