

Women's SAILING Champions League 2025 – World Final in Berlin!

Berlin, August 29, 2025 - From August 29 to 31, all eyes in international club sailing turn to Lake Wannsee, as the Women's SAILING Champions League (WSCL) hosts its World Final. 27 all-women teams from 10 nations will go head-to-head in short, high-intensity races to crown the "Best Women's Sailing Club of the Year."

Different wind directions between 5–10 knots are expected across the weekend, perfect for tight tactical racing and fast legs on the WSCL's short-course format. Combined with clear skies and pleasant temperatures, everything points to three spectacular days of sailing on Lake Wannsee.

Austria, Denmark, Spain, Finland, Germany, the Netherlands, Norway, Switzerland, Sweden, and Great Britain are all represented. A truly international lineup showcasing the very best of women's club sailing.

Returning to Berlin is Aarhus Sejlklub (DEN), the defending WSCL champions, who already impressed earlier this season at the SCL Final in Kiel. Challengers include strong teams like Norddeutscher Regatta Verein (2nd place 2024) and Münchner Yacht-Club (3rd place 2024).

The level of competition continues to rise as does the global profile of women's sailing and the WSCL itself.

But this event is about more than winning. It's about connecting across borders, sharing time on the water, and celebrating the power and progress of women in sailing.

Racing takes place on Lake Wannsee, in collaboration with Berlin's vibrant sailing community.
