1. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 1.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board online: [Link](#)
- 1.2. The event will take place on the Innerfjord Kiel.
- 1.3. The Race Office will be at the DSBL sprinter, located in front of the Hotel Kieler Yacht Club.

2. CHANGES TO NOTICE OF RACE / SAILING INSTRUCTION

Changes to the Notice of Race (NoR) or the Sailing Instruction (SI) will be posted on the official notice board (ONB) or distributed to all teams no later than 30 minutes before they will take effect, except that any change to the time schedule of races will be posted by 21.00 hrs the day before it will take effect.

Obstructions

The entrance to the military port is marked with a restricted area buoy. Entering this area is strictly prohibited. A breach of this sailing instruction is not open to protest by boats but is subject to action by umpires in accordance with UF 3.4(a)(6).

Speedlimit

A speed limit is in effect throughout the entire inner fjord; please observe it.

3. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed on the lawn in front of the clubhouse.

4. Add New point to 10. START of Season SI

The Race Committee intends to utilize the Velocitek RTK system for all race starts to identify OCS boats and notify them via digital signals to each boat's Velocitek unit.

If the Race Committee determines that the system will not be used and RRS 29.1 should apply, they will display Flag G prior to or together with the warning signal.

When Velocitek is used individual OCS boats will be notified digitally via their Velocitek unit. A red light displayed on the boat's RTK Puck indicates that the boat started correctly. Boats identified as OCS will also be notified digitally via their Velocitek unit upon returning to the

pre-start side of the starting line. This changes RRS 29.1.

5. OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats will be marked with white flags carrying black letters as follows:

Race committee: white "RC"

Umpire: black flag with "Jury"

Press: "P" or "PRESS" or "Presse"

Repair service: "Repair"

Media / TV: "Media"
